## Advertisement for applications for Postdoctoral Research position: ECARESA-KENYA PROJECT

### **The offer background**

The ECARESA Kenya project is funded by NORAD as part of an aquaculture capacity building in Africa consortium of eight African Universities and one Norwegian University. It is hosted in the University of Nairobi at the above department and wishes to recruit applicants to carry out research in aquaculture related topics.

### **The objectives of the research position**

The objective of the post-doctoral research offer is to build capacity at the university and strengthen research in aquaculture in Kenya as a follow up of the doctoral studies previously sponsored under Norad grant in bacteriology, virology and pathology disciplines.

The selected candidate will undertake studies in aquaculture in any of the above disciplines under guidance from the project coordinator to enhance their capacity in practicing aquatic health management and disease prevention and control.

### **Requirements and qualification**

Applicants are required to have a doctoral degree in any other disciplines of bacteriology, virology and pathology acquired under the immediately previous Norad sponsored fish project at the department.

### **Application process**

The advertisement will be on the university and department websites. Interested candidates will submit a letter indicating their intention to undertake research work in aquaculture and should include a brief testimonial on what motivates them to study aquaculture under this project and a concept note of a study proposal not exceed five pages of Times Roman 12 font print details.

They will indicate their qualifications and the institution where they studied; provide the names, email addresses and telephone numbers of three referees and attach the certificates of their qualifications as well as the national ID.
